

Dear Senior Families,

We are very proud of your child for reaching this incredible milestone: High School Graduation!

Though circumstances will not allow us to be together in one venue to recognize your child's accomplishment, we have created a plan that we think will enable us to celebrate this important event together.

**We will be holding a Graduation Car Processional on
Wednesday, June 17, at 6:00 PM.**

The parameters of the event will be as follows:

- To avoid a long line of cars, we have designated times for cars to arrive. Please arrive at Bridge at the following times based on the first letter of your child's last name:
 - A through D arrive at 5:45
 - E through M arrive at 6:25
 - N through Z arrive at 6:45
- Beginning promptly at 6:00, cars will begin proceeding down Pulaski St. (which is a one-way road heading east).
- Each car will stop at a clearly marked spot at which the graduate will exit the car wearing a mask and receive their diploma from Mr. Elliott.
 - We will have a professional photographer on hand and pictures will be mailed home.
 - *For health reasons, we ask that only the graduate exit the car*
 - After receiving their diploma, the graduate will reenter the car and the family will drive away.
 - This format will be repeated until every graduate has received their diploma
- The event will be live-streamed on YouTube
- A slide show of the event will be created and sent to all families
- Staff will be placed with appropriate spacing along the route to wish the graduates congratulations!

On the day of the processional, please ensure the following:

- Your graduate is sitting on the passenger side of the car next to a car door wearing their cap and gown
 - *call 203-336-9999 to make an appointment to pick up your cap and gown!*
- Your graduate's name is prominently displayed, on a poster board or large piece of paper, on the passenger side of your car

Please note that if state health and safety guidelines allow, we will hold a traditional graduation ceremony by August 15 for all who can attend.
