	2 spiral bound notebooks (for health and guided reading)
	5 two-pocket folders (for English, Science, Social Studies, Math and Guided Reading)
	Lined, loose leaf paper
	Locker Lock – your choice of lock, either padlock or combination
	Boxes of #2 pencils
	1 box of blue or black stick pens (NO “clicky” pens allowed). Bring AT LEAST three pens with you each day.
	8th GRADERS ONLY: One scientific calculator, Texas Instruments brand, solar powered, Model #TI 30x–IIs. This specific model is required–no substitutions. Should cost NO MORE than \$15!

	<p><u>UNIFORM:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>SHIRTS:</u> <i>PLAIN navy blue long and/or short sleeved polo shirt (no logos, no designs).</i> • <u>PANTS:</u> <i>Absolutely PLAIN (no cargo pants, extra pockets, stitching on the back pockets, joggers, skinny-pants, denim, corduroy) tan Docker/khaki-style pants shorts or skirts</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <i>*shorts and skirts must be to the knee or longer</i> <i>*Pants must be worn at the waist</i> • <u>OUTERWEAR:</u> <i>Blue or black PLAIN (NO hoods, logos or designs) sweater, sweatshirt or fleece-type sweater for over the uniform shirt for cold rooms and days (students are also allowed to wear a long sleeved tee-shirt UNDER the uniform polo shirt to keep warm)</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <i>*All non-uniform clothing must be kept in lockers even if the student is cold</i> • <u>SHOES:</u> <i>Comfortable shoes; all shoes must have backs: no slides or flip flops allowed</i> • <i>NO headgear (hats, bandanas, du-rags) allowed</i> <p style="text-align: center;"><i>Reminder: When students are in the proper uniform all week they earn a dress down day every Friday!</i></p>
